Urban Design Award

Regulations

1. Competition organizer

Faculty of Architecture CTU Prague
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Co-organizers : technical universities with urban design and city planning programs in good standing for the current academic year

Partner : Czech Association for Urban and Regional Planning

Competition secretary is appointed by the organizer.

2. Subject and the goal of the competition

The purpose of the competition is to provide for mutual comparison of design studio outcomes in the international context. Only entries authorized by the studio lecturer / tutor as urban design or town planning design shall be submitted. The entries may represent one or two semesters of an academic year. No diploma projects are permitted.

3. Type of the competition and its announcement

Competition is not anonymous and it is announced by the organizer and co-organizers via the Internet.

Awarded entries will be published in professional periodicals. There will be an annual report presenting achievements and exhibitions at all participating schools and at partner venues.

Language

Entries may be elaborated in mother language, the annotation shall be in English.

4. Participants

Participants must be full time degree program students of any European faculty of architecture or city planning.

5. Entry requirements

The entry format and content shall follow the application form instructions issued by the organizer.

The entry shall be submitted in A3 format (larger drawings must be folded).

In case the entry is linked to previous design work it shall be clearly stated and documented.

6. Entry submission

The application form must be registered by competition secretary by the deadline set by the organizer. The entry must be delivered to the place specified by the organizer or co-organizer (works might be collected in the home university). The entry must be delivered before the deadline including with use of postal or delivery service.

7. Evaluation criteria

Creativity and methodological approach to solution of current urban challenges will be examined. There might be competition categories introduced in case of sufficient entries with similar subject.

Criteria for evaluation without preferences:

- Quality of the concept in wider urban context
- Urban design and architectural quality
- Effectiveness and feasibility of the design

8. Jury

The number of jury members is fixed by the organizer. There must be an odd number of jury members and a minimum of 5 with the majority of jury members coming from non-academic professional society including partner representative. Jury candidates from universities will be drawn during the partner's official venue (congress) in the case there will be too many jury candidates in total. A university which jury member served three times in sequence will be excluded from the next selection. Only one representative from one institution is entitled to become jury a member. The jury chair is elected by jury members during the first jury session.

9. Awards

Financial funds for the awards and the workings (transportation, exhibitions etc.) are to be assured by organizer, co-organizers and partner: 600,- EUR each to be paid per academic

year. The First Prize money is to be awarded in full level, the other prize money may be redistributed by the jury. The number of awards is not specified, nevertheless the minimal award money shall not be below 100 EUR. The jury will decide on the number of awarded entries. Prize money may be collected from public bodies, professional institutions and the private sector.

10. Key dates and deadlines

The competition is announced in May. The entry submission deadline is set up by the organizer. The jury shall meet in autumn. The competition results must be announced no more than 3 months after the jury decision.

11. Clause about acceptance of the competition regulations

The organizer, co-organizers, partner, secretary and jury members acknowledge these regulations and declare its acceptance.

The competition participants accept the Regulations including all conditions as a contract and bind themselves to respect the jury decision which follows the Regulation.

Acceptance of the exhibition of the entries by participants

The participants accept free of charge copyright and public exhibition of the entries in the frame of the promotion of the competition.

12. Approval of the Regulations

These Regulations were approved by the organizer, co-organizers and the Partner on June 30, 2019.
